

Frequently Asked Questions about the SLE Program

Can I go to more than one SLE site?

- Yes, as long as you have gone through all the steps in the SLE approval process.

Do I have to do hours over the summer?

- No.
- Doing summer hours is optional and you may earn up to 75 hours toward your hourly graduation requirement.

Do I have to complete a certain number of hours by a certain point in time?

- Ideally, yes.
- The goal (which will be a grade) will be to complete 25% of the required hours by the end of Marking Period 1, 50% by the end of Marking Period 2, 75% by the end of Marking Period 3, and all hours completed by June.

Can I finish my hours early?

- Definitely!

Does the school provide transportation to my SLE site?

- No.

Will I be graded in the SLE course?

- Yes.
- Please note that you will see number grades in the gradebook during senior year but the marking period grades will only appear as P or F (pass or fail).
- You will be evaluated by your SLE site mentor/s and there will be other requirements that will be shared in Google Classroom.

I won't be on the Denville campus so how will I know what is happening for SLE?

- Mr. Bedell and Mrs. Sevola will contact all students via MCVTS email and Google Classroom. It is imperative that you check your MCVTS email and Google Classroom often starting in your junior year.
- Grades will be posted in the Genesis or Aspen gradebook starting in September of your senior year.

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
